GDC lylhkothi organizes educational and enlightening excursion in order to enhance the intellectual skills of the students .



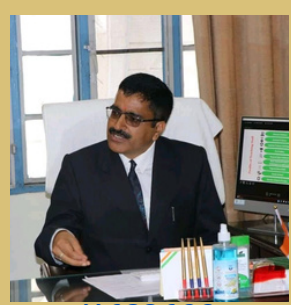
### CO-CURRICULAR & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

## NSS ACTIVITIES

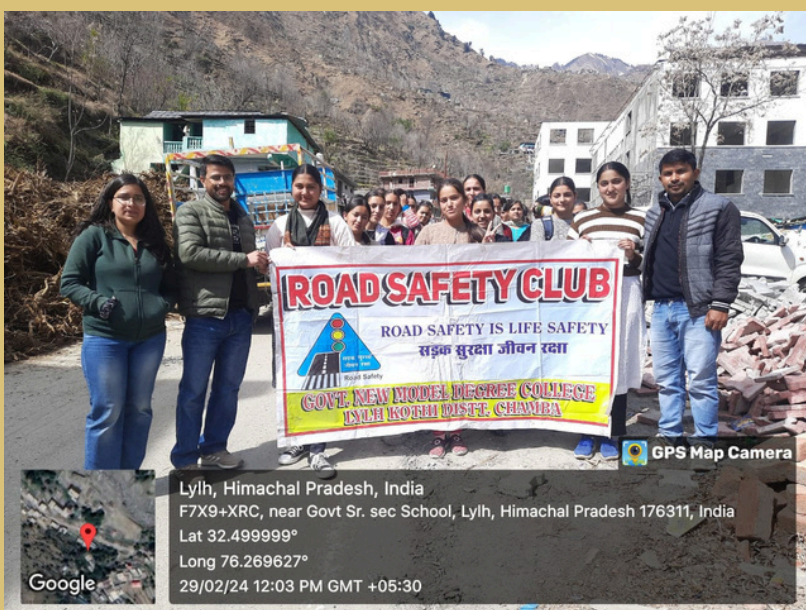




## Empowering Conversation: “Red Ribbon Club’s HIV Awareness Session”

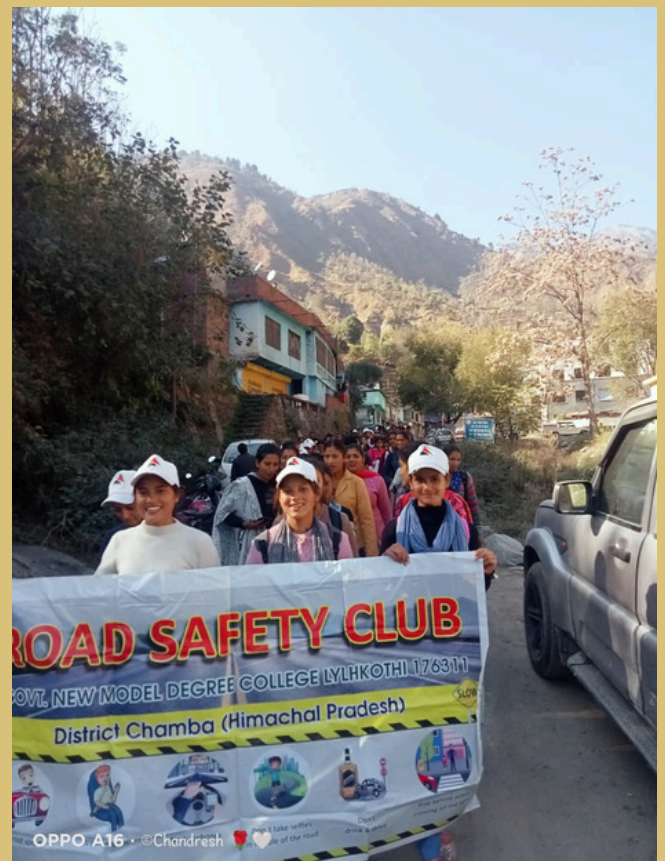
## *Enlighten lecture on traffic Rules and Safety*
